- Built a dynamic website using React & Flask hosted on AWS to display data on endangered species
- Collected & cleaned data from 3 external APIs using Python scripts, resulting in a relational database of 499 unique plants, animals, & states stored across 12 tables
- Implemented searching, sorting, & filtering of data using SQLAlchemy, resulting in a RESTful API capable of multiple queries & pagination
