WHAT THIS COURSE WANTS TO ACHIEVE

COURSE WORK

- Weekly (short), and Bi-weekly (long) essays

 - Should include helpful feedback for improving writing clarity
 - Will be graded on your feedback
- Daily presentations of work and/or current events
- Midterm paper
- Final project, including report/long essay and a presentation

COURSE FORMAT

- At the beginning of every class, students will be chosen/ volunteer to present on their essays, essays they peerreviewed, or current events
- Background material on that day's topic
- Class discussion of related issues
 - Participation is expected
 - Instapoll on Canvas used to poll opinions and take attendance
